AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST PENNSBORO, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING AND REVISING ORDINANCE NO. 737-2007, CHAPTER 27, ZONING ORDINANCE UNDER THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST PENNSBORO TOWNSHIP BY AMENDING CHAPTER 27, ZONING, PART 20, SIGNS, TO DEFINE AND PROVIDE FOR ZONING PERMITS AND FEES FOR SIGNS, STANDARDS AND REGULATIONS FOR SIGNAGE THROUGHOUT DIFFERING ZONING DISTRICTS IN THE TOWNSHIP AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH.

Annual Public Notice of Special Education Services and Programs, Services for Gifted Students, and Services for Protected Handicapped Students Notice to Parents

According to state and federal special education regulations, annual public notice to parents of children who reside within a school district regarding child find responsibilities. School districts (SDs), intermediate units (IUs) and charter schools (CSs) are required to conduct child find activities for children who may be eligible for services via Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973.

This notice shall inform parents throughout the school district, intermediate unit, and charter school of the child identification activities and of the procedures followed to ensure confidentiality of information pertaining to students with disabilities or eligible young children. In addition to this public notice, each school district, intermediate unit, and charter school shall publish written information in the handbook and on the web site.

Children age three through the age of admission to first grade are also eligible if they have developmental delays and, as a result, need Special Education and Related Services. Developmental delay is defined as a child who is less than the age of beginners and at least 3 years of age and is considered to have a developmental delay when one of the following exists:

(i) The child's score, on a developmental assessment device, on an assessment instrument which yields a score in months, indicates that the child is delayed by 25% of the child's chronological age in one or more developmental areas. (ii) The child is delayed in one or more of the developmental test performance of 1.5 standard deviations below the mean on standardized tests.

Each school district, intermediate unit, and charter school has a procedure in place by which parents can request an evaluation. For information about procedures applicable to your child, contact the school that your child attends.

Consent School entities cannot proceed with an evaluation, or with the initial provision of special education and related services, without the written consent of the parents. For additional information related to consent, please refer to the Pre-Admission Requirements Notice for Written Notice (NOREP/PWN). Your written consent is required before initial services can be provided.

Program Development Once the evaluation process is completed, a team of qualified professionals and parents determine whether the child is eligible. If the child is eligible, the Individualized Education Program team meets, develops the program, and determines the educational placement, school district staff, intermediate unit staff, and/or charter school staff will issue a Notice of Recommended Educational Placement/Prior Written Notice (NOREP/PWN).

Confidentiality of Information: The school districts, intermediate units and charter schools maintain records concerning all children enrolled in the school, including students with disabilities. We request confidentiality. Your consent, or consent of an eligible child who has reached the age of majority under state law, must be obtained before personally identifiable information is released, except as permitted under the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).
